## Campbell Chatter

Dear Families,

Welcome back to 2018! I hope everyone had an enjoyable and relaxing long break. I'd like to warmly welcome all of our new families to the Campbell Primary School community.

In 2017 we started a school blog on google communities to showcase and share some of the exciting learning happening at Campbell Primary School. We are again adding to the blog at the end of each week 2, 4, 6, 8 and 10. All families are able to view the community through visiting <http://bit.ly/CampbellPrimary>. If you have a google plus account, you are also able to join the community. To do this you will have to click on the 'ask to join' button, and wait for one of our staff moderators to accept your request.

I will again be the school's Special Needs and Disability Education Coordinator. Should you need any support or information around this area, or would simply like to touch base with me, please do not hesitate to contact me through the school's front office. I will continue to work closely with the school's psychologist, Annette Gloeckler who is with us every Tuesday and every second Thursday. Should you wish to contact her, a referral sheet can be obtained through class teachers, or appointments can be made through the front office. An important part of our school's special needs program is the Individual Learning Plan process. We will be holding initial meetings in week four of this term. The vast majority of meetings have been scheduled for Tuesday 27 February. Letters will be sent out by the end of the week, letting you know the time and location of the meeting.

We will again be providing an enrichment program for students in years 1-6. Within our 3-4 and 5-6 groups we will again have a dedicated English and Humanities group, and a Mathematics group. There are limited places in our program. We take into account parent recommendation, teacher identification, and results of assessments when selecting students who would benefit from these sessions. Particularly, for parents of new students, should you believe your child would be a suitable candidate for these sessions, please collect a questionnaire from the school's front office that is used to consider student selection. For existing students continuing in enrichment, notes will be sent out this week with most groups starting in week 3.

Campbell is well resourced in terms of technology where students from years 2-6 regularly use the Google Apps for Education suite and chromebooks to support their learning. In 2018, we continue to have a 1:1 ratio of chromebooks for students in years 5/6, and a 1:2 ratio for students in years 3/4. We have a class set of chromebooks that is shared between our three year 2 students. We also have a bank of 20 iPads which are used predominately in the early years. As a school, we value the use of technology and see it as an important resource to support teachers and students. In 2017 with some support from our wonderful P and C, we purchased a number of resources for students to effectively engage with the Australian Curriculum Digital Technologies subject area. This is an area that will continue to be of focus, where we will have a number of staff exploring how best we can support our students in this increasingly important subject area.
