NAPLAN provides a useful snapshot of information on an individual's progress in literacy and numeracy skills. This information also assists schools to determine which programs are being effective and areas where we need to improve. Our NAPLAN results in conjunction with our ongoing classroom assessments and data collection is used regularly to inform the teaching and learning practices at Campbell Primary School to maximise student outcomes.

Last week students in Year 3 and 5 should have received their individual NAPLAN reports.
